2015 Red Wine, "La Famille Des Marais" Yakima Valley

The Des Marais family settled and farmed in the Moxee Valley near Yakima, WA in the late 1800's. Here, the family helped establish hops as a major crop for the area and the extended family still farms today. These early French Canadian families brought their traditions and sense of hard work to build a beautiful farming community minutes from our Yakima Valley winery.

VINEYARD NOTES

Red Willow Vineyard, Union Gap Vineyard, DuBrul Vineyard

TASTING NOTES

72% Merlot, 28% Cabernet Sauvignon

This blend of mostly Cabernet comes from three distinct vineyards in the Yakima Valley and it shows, bursting with aromas of dark, ripe cherries and baking spice. The first sip slides past the front of your tongue and lingers on the back with a medium to high tannin structure. Flavors of raspberry tart and dried pepper hit all parts of your mouth and are followed by a juicy finish.

VINIFICATION

Aged in French oak barrels for 30 months. 58% new oak, 42% neutral barrels.
