VINEYARD NOTES

Hugh and Kathy Shiels planted DuBrul Vineyard and meticulously maintain their hilltop vines in the Yakima Valley of Washington. The depth of flavor and concentration are unlike any that we have come across in the West Coast due to the growing area, severity of pruning and minuscule yields. The small clusters yielded intensely flavored fruit with beautifully balanced acidity. Once in the winery, only minimal traditional handling practices were employed.

TASTING NOTES

This Owen Roe favorite is back with bold DuBrul Vineyard charisma! A dark red hue in the glass leads to a beautiful, medium-bodied 100% Cabernet Sauvignon, brimming with aromas of blackberry, cinnamon and tea. The first taste shows balanced acidity with flavors of dark brambly fruit, cocoa, baking spice and cedar. Firm tannins enhance the finish and will aid cellaring this wine long term. Cellar through 2030.

Aged 22 months in 53% new French oak barrels.
