### TASTING NOTES

We decided to bring back the Lady Rosa label with this delicious blend of Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Merlot. The grapes for the Lady Rosa Red Wine are from the small hillside blocks situated in the high elevations sites of western Yakima Valley. The vineyards yielded their small crop with ethereal aromas and wonderfully rich fruit flavors with fragrance of violets and natural balanced acidity.
